What is a development control plan and site-specific development controls?

The Wagga Wagga Development Control Plan 2010 (DCP) contains controls for the purpose of guiding how development occurs and to set development outcomes.

Site specific controls are controls that apply to a certain area with the aim to address concerns that relate to a site or precinct.

The DCP is a document that supports Council's Wagga Wagga Local Environmental Plan 2010 (LEP). The LEP provides the legislative framework for developments. These site-specific controls are in response to changes proposed to the LEP and feedback received in response to the proposed LEP changes.

Where will these controls apply?

The controls will apply to the mixeduse precinct bound by Morgan, Murray and Forsyth Streets.

What is the purpose of sitespecific controls?

The purpose of the site-specific controls is to address key issues raised with respect to future development within the precinct.

The site-specific controls aim to address the following:

- Traffic and parking
- Design and layout
- Height distribution
- Setbacks
- Public open space and recreation
- Stormwater






What has occurred already and what is the process moving forward?

Council has recently undertaken public consultation on proposed amendments to the LEP. The proposed site-specific controls are in response to concerns raised during this engagement.

If the LEP and DCP changes are adopted, this would facilitate development applications for the site. The development application is where detailed design and development outcomes will be proposed.
